Geophysical Information for Teachers (GIFT) Workshops allow formal and informal K-12 science educators to learn about the latest geoscience research from the scientists making the discoveries, explore new classroom resources for their students, and visit exhibits and technical sessions of the American Geophysical Union (AGU) Fall Meeting for free. AGU collaborates with the National Earth Science Teachers' Association (NESTA) to run GIFT workshops at the Fall Meeting.

The 2018 Fall Meeting is being held in Washington D.C. from December 10-14 at the Convention Center.
